# From the Principal's Desk...

Dear SME Families,

Where does the fundraising money go? is a question we field every year. I feel that is a fair question, and I personally enjoy responding because of the answer, which is - 100% of the money raised throughout the year stays with St. Mary's Elementary School. The support we have felt in recent years has helped to enable our school's growth, and our HSA leadership team has done a fabulous job supporting and contributing to the mission of SME. Our collaboration has allowed all of us to flourish!

Specifically, we are able to host community events such as our Back to School Bash and Trunk or Treat at no cost because HSA is able to sponsor them and absorb the financial burden. Additionally, we were able to install a new water bottle water fountain, which was graciously donated by HSA. In addition to helping defer the cost of tuition, your support also contributes to updating learning spaces and making capital improvements to our classrooms. In short, every dollar we collect is invested in growing St. Mary's Elementary School, while we also work together to keep the cost of tuition as affordable as possible.

Various committees and groups work tirelessly to try to make our tuition rates as affordable as possible. In addition to offering a parishioner rate and a discount for multiple children, St. Mary's Elementary School also offers a Referral Program and RAISE RIGHT Incentive. Every new K-8 family that is referred to SME by one of our current 2023-2024 families and registers for the 2024-2025 school year will receive a \$250.00 tuition voucher. The referring family will also receive a \$250.00 tuition voucher. If this applies to you, one of our current families, please submit the appropriate paperwork when your referred family registers so that we will be able to credit your account! Our RAISE RIGHT program offers you incentive to reduce tuition cost, as well. Profit from purchases will be allocated towards your tuition account.

While these programs greatly help to bring funds into the school and keep the cost of tuition lower, our largest fundraising event of the year is our Mega Raffle. Did you know that funds raised from this event help to salary teachers and staff, build our academic curriculum, and offer extracurriculars? Per your tuition agreement, all families are expected to pur-<u>chase or sell two tickets to this raffle</u>. Currently, only a small minority of families have contributed to this fundraiser.

This year's Mega Raffle event will take place at St. Mary's High School on Friday, June 7, beginning at 6:00 PM. The grand prize is \$35,000, and there are 13 additional prizes to be won.

If this event will be successful, we are very much in need of your help. In addition to needing to sell as many of the remaining tickets as possible, we are also seeking volunteers to help with various aspects of running the event. Our Mega Raffle Committee is offering incentives for volunteers as a thank you for your time and efforts. Please see the extended message below for additional details.

It is vitally important that our school participates in this fundraiser. Due to continued inflation and rising expenses, our cost of operation has increased dramatically. The best way to help keep down the cost of tuition is by fulfilling your Fundraising Participation Responsibility.
