## FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK...

Greetings, Friends and Families of St. Mary's Elementary School,

It is with great pleasure and enthusiasm that I contribute to this week's edition of our weekly newsletter! Recently, I have spent much of my time during the school day working and meeting with our middle school students. These productive conversations keep lines of communication open, which helps all of us be and continue to grow into the best version of ourselves.

When speaking with some 6th graders, it was mentioned that our school has seen a lot of growth in our recent past, and, as a result, we need to respond to the needs of our increased student population by offering more extracurricular opportunities. I share this conversation with everyone to demonstrate the maturity of some of our middle school students and the results of engaging in open, transparent communication.

In addition to our traditional clubs such as Student Council and NJHS, this year we have made an effort to participate in more diocesan events - such as bowling, the spelling bee, and the math competition. Also, Mrs. Guenther and Miss Koszuta have begun our Garden Club. In the near future, you will see raised gardens filled with dirt and new life, as students in K-8 work with our teachers to learn some gardening basics as they develop their green thumbs.

Additionally, our older students have taken on leadership roles to help establish and grow our pillar system, which will continue to grow into a program that continues to offer our school so much! We never want to be complacent, though, and will be returning or establishing additional clubs as early as this week, while also planning to add another wave of extracurriculars next year.

SME is returning a Chess Club. We expect a mix of experienced players and those looking to learn the rules and how to play. After we garner how much interest we have, the goal is to hold tournaments in order to name a seasonal Chess Club champion! Similarly, interested students will gather socially to play various board games in our Board Game Club! After learning of our participants' interests, we will host regular gatherings for our students who enjoy playing board games to gather together and enjoy each other's company while playing friendly games. Our students shared how much they enjoy spending time at SME - this is an opportunity for them to make and grow friendships here at our school.

By the end of the week, we will be sharing a Google Form interest survey to better understand what our students would like us to offer. On this Form, your son or daughter will read about our Video Game Club, Book Club, Cooking Club, Dance Lab, and First Aid and Safety Club. We will include a brief description of what we plan each club to offer! Completing this form will help inform us at the school how many moderators we will need, what we should plan to offer, etc. If your son or daughter is interested in getting more involved in the school community, please have him or her complete it.

Looking forward to next year, we are working to build our STEM offerings, including a Technology/Engineering Club, a Robotics Club, and Maker Faire offerings. If you are interested in helping to moderate any of these clubs, please let me know, as we are always looking to involve more parents and grow our extracurricular offerings.

Reminder: Families earn 100% of rebates up to \$250 and an 80/20 split thereafter.

### About the process:

RaiseRight credits are processed quarterly: March, June, September, and December. Mrs. Jezuit applies credits to tuition accounts based on the reports generated and received from RaiseRight. The RaiseRight office is not able to look into individual tuition accounts. If you (or a family member) is purchasing cards to help reduce your tuition you/they **must** designate the recipient family when opening an online account **or** by indicating the family name on paper order forms. Without this information the RaiseRight office has no way of knowing where to assign credits.

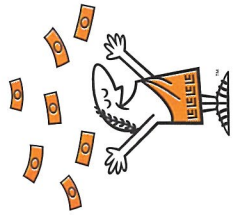

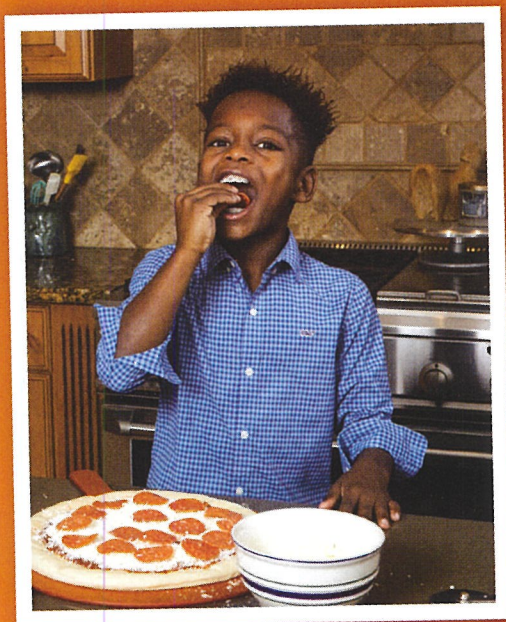
